- 4 Learners can use bilingual paper/electronic dictionaries for one passage, and one without the use of a dictionary.
- 5 Definitions

Complex refers to a wide range of vocabulary and tenses in sentences containing one or more dependent clauses, and complicated grammatical structures. It consists of many different and connected parts. *Unfamiliar* refers to topics and settings that are outside the learner's normal personal

experience.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Translate complex passages and unfamiliar topics written in Vagahau Niue into English.

Range a minimum of two passages required.

Performance criteria

1.1 The translation demonstrates knowledge of complex Vagahau Niue that is consistent with context and situation.

Range includes – complex vocabulary, language structures, protocols.

- 1.2 The English translation is consistent with the meanings in the Vagahau Niue passage.
- 1.3 Translation is expressed in English and avoids transliterations.
