Official Information Act Request

Thank you for your refined request on 3 April 2023, under the Official Information Act 1982, for the following information:

This document contains specific examples of exam materials that are to be used in the 2023 external assessments. In this case, the unpublished exam material for 2023 would be compromised if released and become unusable.
