

## Official Information Act Request

Thank you for your request of 14 May 2024, under the Official Information Act 1982. With your agreement your original request was amended to the following information:

Title: IQA assessments of Bachelor of Education degrees from Indian Universities

From 1 January 2020 to 13 May 2024, what is the count of applicants, possessing a Bachelor of Education credential from Indian universities, have attained positive teaching evaluation by NZQA for meeting the core knowledge requirement of a New Zealand initial teacher education program for teaching within the Secondary sector?

From 1 January 2020 to 13 May 2024, what is the count of applicants, possessing a Bachelor of Education credential from Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, Punjab, India, have attained positive teaching evaluation by NZQA for meeting the core knowledge requirement of a New Zealand initial teacher education program for teaching within the secondary sector?

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982.

## Response

From 1 January 2020 to 13 May 2024, 482 applicants possessed a Bachelor of Education credential from Indian universities and attained a positive teaching evaluation by NZQA for meeting the core knowledge requirement of a New Zealand initial teacher education program for teaching within the Secondary sector.

From 1 January 2020 to 13 May 2024, 81 applicants possessed a Bachelor of Education credential from Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, Punjab, India, and attained a positive teaching evaluation by NZQA for meeting the core knowledge requirement of a New Zealand initial teacher education program for teaching within the secondary sector.
