Official Information Act Request

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 on 6 November 2023:

I wish to lodge an Official Information Act request seeking summary achievement data relating to the schools that were formerly set up as Charter Schools, i.e. Partnership Schools. The schools in question were as follows for each of the achievement years' data I am seeking:

For each of the schools named above and for each of the years it was in operation, as shown in the above table, I am seeking the following NCEA achievement data:

- The proportion of credits earned via achievement standards and the proportion of credits earned via unit standards as a percentage of the total credits earned;*
- The proportion of credits earned via internal assessment and the proportion of credits earned via external assessment as a percentage of the total credits earned;*
- The achievement rate for internally assessed standards and the achievement rate for externally assessed standards.*

Response

Please refer to the attached spreadsheet *PRS-5233 Charter School Achievementv1.0*. The data provided is as of 14 November 2023.

The data:

- includes all Unit Standards, and internally and externally assessed Achievement Standards;
- does not include provisional results and withdrawn entries and results;
- does not include results for Te Kopuku High (provider 751) for the period 2014 to 2018, as no results were submitted and therefore are held by NZQA, and
- data for each academic year is as at April of the following year.

Definitions of table column headings in the spreadsheet

Question 1:

- *Proportion of credits earned via Unit Standards* has been interpreted as the proportion (percentage) of credits which were attained using unit standards out of all credits attained (*credits attained* means the sum of credits from standards with an achieved result or higher).
- *Proportion of credits earned via Achievement Standards* has been interpreted as the proportion of credits which were attained using achievement standards out of all credits attained.

Question 2:

- *Proportion of credits earned via External Standards* has been interpreted as the proportion of credits attained using externally assessed achievement standards out of all credits attained.
Note: for the time period specified, there were no externally assessed unit standards.
- *Proportion of credits earned via Internal Standards* has been interpreted as the proportion of credits attained using internally assessed achievement standards and unit standards out of all credits attained.

Question 3:

- *External Standards Achievement %* means the percentage of results (not credits) which had an achieved grade or higher out of all externally assessed achievement standards.
- *Internal Standards Achievement %* means the percentage of results which had an achieved grade or higher out of all internally assessed achievement standards and unit standards.

Further explanatory notes:

- We have only used achieved results (or higher) for questions 1 and 2. Schools will have assessed standards where the credits were not attained, i.e. Not Achieved results.
- Where external achievement has a '~', there were no externally assessed standards for the provider that year.
- There were only a small number of results assessed by provider 691 (Te Pumanawa O Te Wairua) in 2017.
- Schools which have 0.0% Unit Standard credits earned may have assessed the unit standards but attained a 0% achievement rate.
