In response to your request, please see the attached spreadsheet *PRS-5714 OIA NCEA Pilot School and Special Assessment Data.* Each year requested has been provided on its own tab.

Note: the information provided relates to the schools at which the students completed the assessments. There are a few cases where students enrolled in another school completed assessments at an identified school.

We can confirm that St Andrew's College, Cashmere High School, and Darfield High School did not participate in the 2022 NCEA NZC Level 1 Pilots. Te Kura Kaupapa Maori o Te Whanau Tahi participated in the 2022 NCEA TMoA Level L1 Mini Pilots. The '2022' tab of the attached spreadsheet, contains the full list of schools for your reference.

Regarding your question whether NZQA collected student voice from those students who received SAC entitlements, we have understood 'student voice' to mean survey responses from these students regarding their experience during the NCEA Level 1 pilots. We did not gather this information; Collection of student voice was part of the Ministry of Education's commissioned evaluation of the 2022 NZC pilots and TMoA mini-pilots by Evaluation Associates and the Education Review Office respectively.
