## **Official Information Act Request**

Thank you for your request of 11 July 2025, under the Official Information Act 1982, for the following information:

ATAR Range Statistics: For each year from 2020 to 2024:

- Number of candidates who obtained a converted ATAR between 95.0 and 97.0
- Number of candidates who obtained a converted ATAR between 97.0 and 99.5
- Number of candidates who obtained a converted ATAR between 99.5 and 99.95
- The minimum, median, and maximum number of Excellence credits gained by candidates in the 95.0 to 99.95 ATAR range

## Response

In response to your request, please see the attached spreadsheet *PRS-6141 OIA – ATAR range* stats v1.0.xlsx which contains information on the:

- Number of candidates who obtained an ATAR between each of the ranges you have asked for - tab "Candidate Count" refers.
- The minimum, median, and maximum number of Excellence credits gained by candidates in the 95.0 to 99.95 ATAR range tab "Excellence" refers.

## Note:

- For the ATAR Ranges, we have changed the end value to avoid double counting students who have ATARs of 97.00 and 99.50:
  - ATAR between 95.0 and 97.0 changed to ATAR between 95.00 and 96.95 (inclusive)
  - o ATAR between 97.0 and 99.5 changed to ATAR between 97.00 and 99.45 (inclusive)
- ATAR scores range from 99.95 (the top score) to 0.00 in 0.05 increments. 0.05% of the relevant year group is allocated to each ATAR score.
- Excellence credits are those gained at Level 3 or above for candidates falling into required range.
