Official Information Act Request

Thank you for your request of 10 December 2025, via the FYI website and transferred to NZQA from the Ministry of Education on 6 January 2026, under the Official Information Act 1982, for the following information:

Please provide the school-level outcome data for the Common Assessment Activities associated with the NCEA Literacy and Numeracy Co requisite standards for the 2024 and 2025 calendar years. I am requesting this in spreadsheet or machine readable form. I am not seeking names of individual students or any personal identifying information and accept standard statistical suppression where necessary to manage re identification risk.

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982.

In response to your request, please see the attached spreadsheet PRS-6442 LitNum CAAs Output v2.0. This includes school level achievement data (counts and achievement rate) for 2024 and 2025.

Note:

- We have interpreted your request for the school-level outcome data for the Common Assessment activities (CAAs) for the NCEA co-requisite standards as the outcomes of the assessment against each of the six externally assessed NCEA co-requisite unit standards, i.e. for US32406 Numeracy, US32403 Literacy - Reading, US32405 Literacy - Writing, US32413 Te Reo Matatini - Reo Torohū, US32415 Te Reo Matatini - Reo Whakaputa, and US32412 Te Pāngarau.
- For Te Pāngarau and Te Reo Matatini – Reo Whakaputa unit standards where an alternative assessment method, Kete Manarua (portfolio), to the CAA (or Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi) is also available, those results have been included.
- Where a student was assessed in more than one assessment event for a standard during the year, only the last result is counted when determining the overall results for the year.
- Under section 9(2)(a) of the OIA, to protect the privacy of natural persons, the numbers and proportions of achievement have been withheld where the total number of students is fewer than five.
