This rapid response provides additional information as requested following NZQA's Information Update of 23 June on the first NCEA co-requisite assessment event for Literacy - Reading results (OC01785 refers).

NZQA Response

In response to your request for further information on the participation and achievement levels of students in the May 2025 Reading co-requisite assessment, the following tables provide a detailed breakdown of the data for each year level.

Participation

Table 1 presents the number of students who participated in the Reading assessment by year level and whether they were sitting the assessment for the first time or repeating the assessment.

In response to your question about the year level contribution of the overall achievement rate of 61.2% for the May 2025 Reading assessment. Tables 1, 2 and 3 show that the overall achievement rate is predominantly negatively impacted by Years 11 and 12 non-achievement rates.

Achievement by School EQI group

You have also asked for the achievement rates by socio-economic barriers to attainment (School EQI Group) for Reading assessment event 1 2024

Table 4 presents the achievement rates for Event 1 2024 and Event 1 2025, by School EQI group.

Upcoming Briefing -Results for Literacy - Writing, Numeracy, Te Reo Matatini me te Pāngarau

On Thursday 10 July, ahead of results release on 14 July, we will provide you with a briefing on the other co-requisite results for Assessment Event 1.

In that briefing, we will include similar analysis to that provided to you for Literacy - Reading.

We will also brief you on the number of 2025 enrolled students by year level who have met the overall co-requisite requirement, and those who are yet to meet the requirement.

For those Year 12 and Year 13 students who did not meet the co-requisite requirements in 2024, we will provide an update on whether they have met the requirements after Assessment Event 1.

We will also advise you if this means these students have also met the overall requirements for NCEA Level 1 if they were participating in a full NCEA Level 1 programme in 2024.

We can provide you with an indication of the impact of the 2025 co-requisite achievement on the Year 11 2024 participating cohort.
