This information update addendum provides you with the results from the first 2025 NCEA co-requisite assessment event held between 19 and 30 May 2025 covering:

- Pāngarau

As advised, results for Pāngarau were still being finalised late last week and are only able to be provided to you this morning ahead of their release to students and schools this afternoon.

Information

456 students attempted the Pāngarau assessment. Just over 40% of participating students are in Year 10. Just under 25% of participating students are in Year 9.

60.3% (275) achieved the assessment.

Summary of achievement rates

With the results for all six co-requisite standards now available, achievement rates for assessment event 1 of 2025 are summarised below, alongside results from 2024 event 1 and event 2 for comparison.
