## Amendments to New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) Rules

#### Purpose of Report

 This report seeks your approval, under section 253(5) of the Education Act 1989, of amendments to Rules administered by NZQA. These Rule amendments with a 1 April commencement date were approved by the NZQA Board on 27 February 2020. The rule sets with the revised commencement date were approved by the NZQA Board chair on behalf of the Board on 9 April 2020.

#### Background

- 2. As detailed in our earlier submission<sup>1</sup>, NZQA proposed amendments to six Rule sets to align them to the Education (Vocational Education and Training Reform) Amendment Act 2020 (the RoVE Amendment Act). These amendments are mainly technical and reflect:
  - the establishment of the New Zealand Institute of Skills and Technology (NZIST)
  - the establishment of Workforce Development Councils (WDCs)
  - the changes in legal status of Institutes of Technology and Polytechnics (ITPs) and Industry Training Organisations (ITOs)
  - WDCs' legislated functions as appropriate (e.g. programme endorsement).
- 3. NZQA has made amendments to the following six Rule sets to reflect the establishment of the NZIST and WDCs, and changes in legal status of ITPs and ITOs:
  - NZQF Programme Approval and Accreditation Rules 2018 (PAA Rules)
  - NZQF Industry Training Programme Approval Rules 2012 (NZQF Industry TP Rules)
  - NZQF Qualification Listing and Operational Rules 2016
  - Consent to Assess Against Standards on the Directory of Assessment Standards Rules 2011
  - Training Scheme Rules 2012
  - Quality Assurance (including External Evaluation and Review (EER)) Rules 2016

### Discussion

- 4. These Rules were unable to be signed by you by the anticipated commencement date of 1 April 2020 due to the covid19 outbreak. Accordingly, the Rules have been revised with a new commencement date for your approval. The amended Rules with the new commencement date were approved by the NZQA Chair on behalf the Board on 9 April 2020.
- 5. These amended Rules, once they are approved by you, will come into effect 14 days after you have signed them.
- 6. Appendix 1 contains each amended Rule set. The amendments have been made using tracked changes.
- 7. Once you have approved the six sets of Rule amendments by signing and dating them in space provided, they will be published on the NZQA website and presented in the House of Representatives in accordance with section 253(6) & (7) of the Education Act. NZQA will then advise the sector accordingly.
