# Education Report: Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Schools 2020

# Purpose of Report

 This report provides copies of the Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Schools 2020 that were approved by the NZQA Board on 12 December 2019 and asks that your Office provide them to the Office of the Clerk (attention Bills Office) for presenting to the House of Representatives.

### Background

- 2. The Rules concern internal and external assessment in schools, at home, and in tertiary education organisations (who deliver externally assessed achievement standards).
- 3. Changes are made at the end of each year to reflect current policy (and procedures). Following approval from the NZQA Board they must be made available on the NZQA website on 1 February the following year.
- 4. The assessment and examinations rules for 2020 are:
  - Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Schools with Consent to Assess 2020
  - Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Home-Schooled Students 2020
  - Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Tertiary Education Organisations with Consent to Assess Entering Candidates for Achievement Standards 2020

### Authority for making the rules

- 5. NZQA may make rules under section 253 of the Education Act 1989. To be valid, the Rules require the approval of the NZQA Board. The Board Chair has delegated authority form the Board to approve these Rules.
- 6. Under section 253(5) of the Education Act 1989, Ministerial approval is not required for the Rules providing for the conduct of assessments and examinations relating to any qualifications or awards.
- 7. The Rules must be presented in the House of Representatives as disallowable instruments under section 41 of that Legislation Act 2012. Ten copies must be provided to the Office of the Clerk (attention the Bills Office) for presenting in the House of Representatives.
