Final 2017 NCEA and University Entrance Attainment Statistics

Recommended Action

It is recommended you:

- a. **note** that final 2017 NCEA and University Entrance roll-based attainment statistics are now available.
- b. **note** that these final statistics show that Year 12 NCEA Level 2, Year 13 NCEA Level 3 and Year 13 University Entrance attainment rates have increased slightly on 2016, and that Year 11 NCEA Level 1 attainment in 2017 has decreased by 0.9 percentage points compared to 2016.
- c. **note** that NZQA will issue a press release on the final 2017 NCEA and University Entrance statistics on 11 April 2018, and that the attainment data files will be made publicly available via the statistics section of the NZQA website on that day.
- d. **note** that NZQA will signal in the press release that 2017 is the last year for which NZQA will be reporting NCEA and UE attainment using the roll-based measure.
- e. **note** that NZQA's Annual Report on NCEA and New Zealand Scholarship Data and Statistics will be released by NZQA at the end of May 2018.

Final 2017 NCEA and University Entrance Attainment Statistics


Purpose of Report

- 1. You were provided with two reports, *Provisional 2017 NCEA and University Entrance Attainment Statistics* on 16 January 2018 (CR17004 refers), and *Provisional 2017 NCEA and University Entrance Attainment Statistics Updated as at 8 February 2018* on 15 February 2018 (CR 17057 refers).
- 2. Final 2017 NCEA and University Entrance roll-based attainment statistics are now available. This report provides a high level national overview of these statistics, including breakdowns by ethnicity, gender and decile.
- 3. The Ministry of Education has been consulted on this briefing.

Comment

2017 final attainment statistics

4. Figure 1 below shows the final 2017 national roll-based attainment statistics for NCEA and University Entrance by year level, with final 2008 to 2016 attainment rates included for comparison purposes. This gives a 10-year view of NCEA and UE attainment.



- 5. As expected, all attainment rates across the various breakdowns provided have increased on the numbers released to you on 15 February 2018.
- 6. Comparing the final 2017 figures to the 2016 figures:
 - The Year 11 NCEA Level 1 attainment rate is 74.6%, 0.9 percentage points lower than the 2016 figure of 75.5%.

- The Year 12 NCEA Level 2 attainment rate is 78.5%, 0.1 percentage points higher than the 2016 figure of 78.4%.
- The Year 13 NCEA Level 3 2017 attainment rate is 65.7%, 1.2 percentage points higher than the 2016 figure of 64.5%.
- The University Entrance attainment rate is 49.4%, 0.2 percentage points higher than the 2016 figure of 49.2%.
- 7. Tables 1 to 4 in Appendix 1 shows the breakdowns by ethnicity, gender and decile.
- 8. The 2017 Year 13 NCEA Level 3 attainment rates have increased across the board compared with 2016. Comparing the final 2017 figures to the 2016 figures for Year 13 NCEA Level 3, some figures to highlight include:
 - NZ Māori Year 13 NCEA Level 3 attainment has increased by 2.3 percentage points to 56.7%.
 - Pasifika Peoples Year 13 NCEA Level 3 attainment has increased by 4.9 percentage points to 65.3%.
 - Decile 1-3 Year 13 NCEA Level 3 attainment has increased by 1.7 percentage points to 57%.

Next steps

- 9. NZQA will issue a press release on the final 2017 NCEA and University Entrance statistics on 11 April 2018, and the attainment data files will be made publicly available via the statistics section of the NZQA website on that day.
- 10. NZQA will signal in the press release that 2017 is the last year for which NZQA will be reporting NCEA and UE attainment using the roll-based measure.
- 11. NZQA's Annual Report on NCEA and New Zealand Scholarship Data and Statistics will be released by NZQA at the end of May 2018. This provides commentary on all national attainment data and includes administrative information such as the number of reviews and reconsiderations, reports of allegations of examination room breaches, and Special Assessment Conditions data.
