- 5. What percentage of Year 11 Students who sat the MCAT test in the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 gained the following grades in the North Island
 - a. Excellent
 - b. Merit
 - c. Achieved
 - d. Not Achieved
- 6. What percentage of Year 11 Students who sat the MCAT test in the years 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 gained the following grades in the South Island
 - a. Excellent
 - b. Merit
 - c. Achieved

However, this information isn't available until the end of April which is the usual time NZQA completes all final results processing for NCEA. I am sorry that we inadvertently advised you otherwise.
