Review of the list of standards that meet University Entrance literacy requirements

You have requested further information for the Minister of Education about changes following the review of the list of standards that meet the University Entrance literacy requirements (the List).

The review of the List resulted in:

- the addition of 19 standards to the List;
- the removal of 13 standards from the List; and
- determining whether 21 standards currently on the List will continue to count towards reading or writing.

The standards affected are in 23 different domains.

Note there is a net tightening of the reviewed List as while the total number of standards available has increased by six, the number of standards available to meet the writing requirement has reduced from 91 on the original List to 77; this will assist in addressing the key concern expressed in relation to the lack of extended writing skills.

Changes to the List

The review has resulted in changes to the List that will be phased in over a two-year period between 2020 and 2021.

- From January 2020
 - o 19 standards will be added to the List
 - o 7 standards currently on the List will change to count for one of either reading or writing to allow transition to the reviewed List.
- 31 December 2021
 - o 13 standards will be removed from the List
 - o 15 standards currently on the List will remain on the List but will no longer count for one of either reading or writing.
