Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Schools with Consent to Assess 2020, Amendment No.1

1. Authority

1.1 These Amendment Rules are made under section 253(1)(j) of the Education Act 1989.

2. Commencement

2.1 These Amendment Rules come into effect on 9 March 2020.

3. Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Schools with Consent to Assess 2020 amended

3.1 Rule 7.2.1 of the Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Schools with Consent to Assess 2020 (the principal Rules) is amended in the manner shown in the text in the Appendix.

This note is not part of these Rules but indicates their general effect.

This amendment to the principal Rules, which commences on 9 March 2020, increases scholarship awards and corrects a cross-reference.

**Amended text in Rule 7.2.1 of the Assessment
(including Examination) Rules for Schools with
Consent to Assess 2020**

7.2.1 New Zealand Scholarship: Monetary Awards

- a. The New Zealand Scholarship Monetary Awards for 2020 are available to Candidates who meet Rules 5.2 Candidate Eligibility and 5.3 Conditions of Entry and comprise:

Premier Award	- o For the very top <u>5-7</u> to <u>10-12</u> Candidates. The minimum eligibility requirement to be considered for this award is achievement of at least three Scholarships at "Outstanding" level in the same year. The number of recipients for this award is restricted and achieving the minimum requirement will not guarantee an award. - o \$10,000 each year for up to three years for as long as the recipient maintains at least a 'B' grade average each year of their tertiary study.
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Scholarship Award	- o For Candidates who achieve New Zealand Scholarship in three or more subjects in the same year <u>and for Candidates who achieve two Scholarships at "Outstanding" level in the same year.</u> - o \$2,000 each year for up to three years for as long as the recipient maintains at least a 'B' grade average each year of their tertiary study.
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Eligibility to receive a monetary award

- h. A Candidate who defers an award because they are still at school and gains:
- ii. a Single Subject Award in one subject in a year and in a second subject in another year is eligible for two one-off awards of \$500 as long as the student is enrolled in tertiary study as outlined in Rule 7.23.12b.i up to the maximum payment of \$1000 for Single Subject Awards:
