## Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Schools with Consent to Assess 2021, Amendment No.1

### 1. Authority

- 1.1 These Amendment Rules are made under section 452(1)(m) of the Education and Training Act 2020.

### 2. Commencement

- 2.1 These Amendment Rules commence on the 28<sup>th</sup> day after the date the NZQA Board Chair approves these Amendment Rules by signing them on behalf of the NZQA Board.

### 3. Amendment to principal Rules

- 3.1 These Amendment Rules amend the Assessment (including Examination) Rules for Schools with Consent to Assess 2021 (the **principal Rules**).

### 4. Rules 7.1.4 d and 7.1.9 a of the principal Rules replaced

- 4.1 Replace rule 7.1.4 d with:

d. A School must manage any breaches of the rules, in relation to any Common Assessment Task marked by the School, using the School's Breaches of the Rules – Internal Assessment procedures and must follow the instructions supplied by NZQA to the School for the common assessment task involved.

- 4.2 Replace rule 7.1.9 a with:

a. This rule 7.1.9:

- i. applies to all externally assessed standards and Common Assessment Tasks marked by NZQA:
- ii. does not apply to Visual Arts Level 1 or 2, for which a School's Breaches of the Rules – Internal Assessment procedures must be used:
- iii. does not apply to any Common Assessment Task marked by a School, for which that School must use its Breaches of the Rules – Internal Assessment procedures and must follow the instructions supplied by NZQA to the School for the Common Assessment Task involved.

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## 5. New sub-paragraph iv inserted into rule 8.5 d of the principal Rules

### 5.1 After sub-paragraph iii of rule 8.5 d insert:

- iv. For Courses where a student achieves 14 credits in any one of the following subject areas there is no requirement for 3 credits from externally assessed standards:
  1. Hangarau:
  2. Hauora:
  3. Ngā Toi:
  4. Ngā Toi (Ngā Mahi a Te Rēhia):
  5. Ngā Toi (Toi Ataata):
  6. Ngā Toi (Toi Puoro):
  7. Pūtaiao:
  8. Tikanga-a-iwi.

### Explanatory note

This note is not part of these Rules but indicates their general effect.

This amendment to the principal Rules, which commences on the 28<sup>th</sup> day after the date the NZQA Board Chair approves the amendment by signing it on behalf of the NZQA Board:

- (a) clarifies the application of rule 7.1.9 (Breaches of the Rules – External Assessment):
- (b) allows students to gain a course endorsement for specific subjects within Te Marautanga o Aotearoa, if they achieve 14 credits within any one of those subjects without the need to obtain 3 credits from external standards.

The amendment described in (b) above puts the specific subjects within Te Marautanga o Aotearoa in the same position as Physical Education and Religious Studies for which currently there is no need to obtain 3 credits from external standards.
