

Register with NZQA and Apply for a Marking Role

If you are not a registered user, you must register with NZQA.

If you are a registered NZQA User, DO NOT REGISTER AGAIN.

If you are a registered user, LOGIN TO YOUR MARKER HOME PAGE.

IF YOU ARE NOT A REGISTERED USER, YOU MUST REGISTER WITH NZQA.

To register for the first time as an NZQA user follow this link.

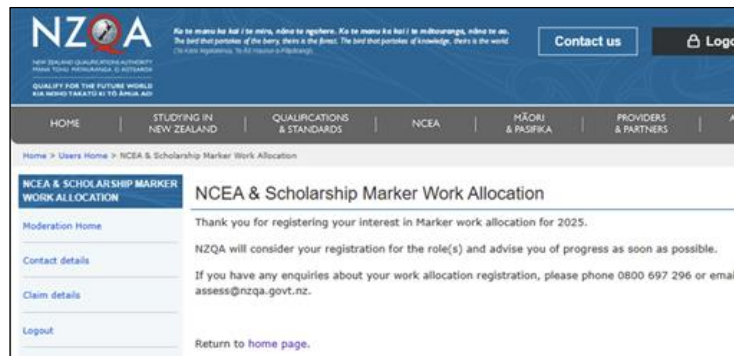
