Format of the assessment

The paper is comprised of three questions. Candidates are required to complete ALL questions.

Questions will have a focus on:

- export-orientated primary production systems
- issues, perspectives, and conflicts that occur in attempting to achieve sustainable production systems
- contemporary issues that have an impact on the production part of the primary production system.

Special notes

Candidates will be required to have detailed understanding of TWO primary production systems from producer to consumer. A primary production system involves the production of one or more products from producer to consumer, e.g. a sheep system might produce wool and meat. Candidates will be required to show understanding of the following contemporary issues:

- Diversification within primary production systems
- The impact of the internet and social media on primary production systems.
