


Resource B: Coming of age





Resource E: Physical abuse exposure

Monoamine oxidase A (MAOA) degrades serotonin, norepinephrine, and dopamine following reuptake from the synaptic cleft, and, therefore, plays a key role in regulating behaviour.

Resource H: Riley's study

Hypotheses:

H1: The number of people a person has emotionally meaningful relationships with is significantly negatively correlated with the amount of time the person expects to live for.

H2: People who live in nursing homes do not have significantly more emotionally meaningful relationships than people of similar age who live independently.
