Format of the assessment

Candidates will be required to write answers in essay format for THREE questions. Each question will require candidates to address a selected quotation / statement or discussion question in their analysis.

Candidates may not use the same material to answer more than one question.

Question One will focus on the relationship between media and society (industry, developments).

Question Two will focus on a candidate's media production experience.

Question Three will focus on reading media texts (genre, readings, representation).
