A title and an introduction to the passage will be given in English. Except for proper nouns, lower case will be used throughout the Latin passage.

The passage of Latin text for each standard will be narrative prose of approximately 130–150 words. The passages will be based on an authentic Latin text that will be modified appropriately for Curriculum Level 7.
