This assessment requires you to discuss a digital outcome you developed within the past 12 months.

If you developed your digital outcome as part of a group, you must write about your role and specific contributions to the project.

Read all parts of the question before you begin. Do not repeat your response in different parts of the question.

Candidates are not permitted to access any resources (either in hard copy or online) other than those supplied in the assessment itself.

**QUESTION**

Name the type of digital outcome you created – i.e. website, app, magazine, animation, etc.

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Name the main software you used to develop the digital component of your outcome.

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(a) (i) Describe the digital outcome you developed.

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(ii) Explain TWO different decisions you made during the development of your digital outcome. These may relate to:

- sequencing of key tasks in the project
- methods used to address end-user considerations
- which resources to use, and why.

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This section asks candidates to write about requirements and implications (stated in the NZQA specifications). This sample uses two very similar question sequences, and candidates should give two different responses. The NZQA exam may be more specific or give a narrower choice.

- (b) (i) Identify one requirement (design feature) that relates to usability, functionality, accessibility, or aesthetics.

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- (ii) Identify one wider implication (effect on people or society) in relation to social, ethical, or legal issues, or to intellectual property, that you needed to consider because of the requirement in (i).

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- (iii) Discuss how the requirement in (i) and the implication in (ii) influenced the development of your digital outcome.

In your answer, include:

- what you decided to do (one clear decision/action)
- why you chose that approach
- a specific example of what you created or implemented in the digital outcome.

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- (iv) Identify a different requirement that relates to usability, functionality, accessibility, or aesthetics.

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- (v) Identify a different wider implication (effect on people or society) in relation to social, ethical, or legal issues, or to intellectual property, that you needed to consider because of the requirement in (iv).

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- (vi) Discuss how your digital outcome addresses the requirement in (iv) and the implication in (v). In your discussion:

- explain what was successful and what was limited
- explain what you prioritised and what that meant for the digital outcome
- support your points with specific examples from the digital outcome.

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In this section, candidates can expand on an earlier decision or introduce a different decision.

- (c) (i) Evaluate one key decision you made in your development process.

In your evaluation, focus on:

- what the decision was and why you made it
- how effective the decision turned out to be (what worked well / what didn't)
- what positive impacts or limitations came from this decision.

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
