1	A4	There is evidence of some detailed understanding – ie a year of living in New Zealand, not enough room inside if it is raining, but overall understanding lacks connections and details. There are also instances of misunderstanding, such as bringing a gift in NZ and lack of detail regarding how life is different for Alexandre.				
2	A4	There is evidence of detailed understanding of the shopping list – ie bread from the bakery because the supermarket bread is not good, and the quantities are accurate. In section b) there is a lack of accurate detailed understanding ie the money is on the table in the living room (not kitchen), the bus is not across the street. Other important information is also not included or is misunderstood ie Dad is going to pick him up because the bags will be too heavy, Dad will wait for him in the car park in front of the supermarket.				
3	A4	Some key information is understood such as making a playlist on Spotify, dropping and breaking the phone which resulted in no music, Dad having an accident after 15 minutes playing cricket. There is, however, a lack of evidence of detailed understanding overall. Important details are not included or misunderstood, such as deciding to go to the park because, despite the sunshine it was too cold to go to the beach, waiting for 4 hours at A&E,
