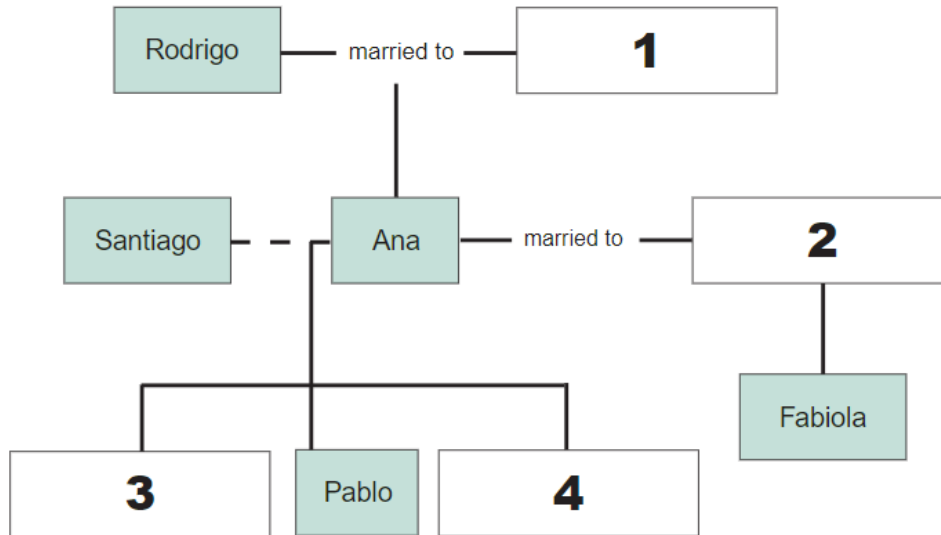

More correct information regarding place of purchase would be needed for a more secure A/04.

They also identify many of the positives of Mexico such as the cathedral, the animals, and Frida Kahlo's house. While some of these ideas are beginning to be linked, e.g. teenagers like animals, some extra details such as his friends not going to the sea as it is too far away are misunderstood and other justifying details are missing or incorrect preventing this from achieving at 05.
