Ua manava mai lo'u tama i le afiafi, sa ma o ai loa i le paka e latalata ane i lo matou fale. Sa ou lagona le fiafia o le a'o la'u aveave ae mulimuli mai ai lagona ole popole nei lavea le ta'avale.

Ua ma feosofi i totonu o le ta'avale. Ua faimai lou tama "toso le fusipa'u, fa'asao le fa'ata, va'ai poo kilia, ki le ta'avale, tu i le vae i le taofi ma tuu i lalo le taofi lima".

Ua ou tago atu fai uma fa'atonuga e pei ona faimai. Ai ona o le ova o lo'u fiafia, ua ou tu ai i le vae penisini, ma oso ai loa le ta'avale. Oka! Pei a pe lo'u fatu i le oso fa'afuasei o le ta'avale ma ou ee ai loa.

Na oso le ta'avale ma so'a le pa, ma omo ai le pito i luma. Ua ou lagona le fefe ma le popole.

Ua amata ona ou tagi ona e taugata le taavale a nai ou matua. Oute faasaga atu i si ou tama, o loo nofo lava e leai ma se leo. Na ia faimai isi ona leo malu "o le measili o loo e saogalemu, aua ole taavale e mafai ona toe fai, ao le ola e na o le tasi lava".

Why is learning to drive memorable for the author?
