Te Whakatakotoranga Aromatawai

Ka whakatau te ākonga i tōna mōhio me tōna mārama ki ngā huāngā me ngā ahuatanga tāpua mā roto mai i ngā tūnga kua whiria e te ākonga.

Me tuku mai te ākonga i tētahi tuhingaroa e kōrero ana mō ngā tūnga e **RUA**. Ko ngā kai i tēnei tuhinga, kia kaua e iti iho i te **WHĀ** o ngā ahuatanga tāpua, kia kaua anō e iti iho i te **WHĀ** o ngā huāngā kia kitea te mōhio me te mārama o te whakamahinga o ēnei ahuatanga o roto i ēnei tūnga.

Tirohia te kuputaka marau o Te Ao Haka mō ngā kupu whakamārama o ngā huāngā me ngā ahuatanga tāpua ([Te Ao Haka | NCEA \(education.govt.nz\)](#)).

Kia kaua e iti iho i te 400 kupu, kaore rānei e whānui ake i te 500 kupu mo tēnei tuhingaroa i te reo Māori, i te reo Pākēhā rānei.

E whakaatu ana te Kete Manarua i tētahi/ētahi tauira hei kōwhiringa mā te kaiako. Mā te kaiako tonu e whiriwhiri mēnā rānei ka whakamahia te/ngā tauira nei, ka whakamahia rānei he mahi whakaharatau, ka whakaritea rānei he Tūmahi Aromatawai anō.

Ngā Herenga Aromatawai

Te Motuhēhē o ngā mahi o ngā ākonga

Me pēhea e mōhiotia ai te motuhēhē o ngā mahi a ngā ākonga? He tukanga, he taunakitanga me whai, e mōhiotia ai nā te ākonga ake āna mahi aromatawai. Kia mataara ngā ākonga, ngā kaiako me te whānau hoki o te kura ki te motuhēhē o ngā mahi a ngā ākonga.

He māmā noa iho te tiki mahi a tangata kē, heoi, mā te mihi e whakaatu, e whakanui hoki i ngā tāngata me ngā puna awhina i puta ai ngā mahi a ngā ākonga.

Hei tauira:

- He rerenga kupu poto e tohu ana i te pūtakenga mai o tētahi kōrero;
- He rārangi tohutoro i te whārangi whakamutunga o ngā mahi;
- He mihi ki ngā puna awhina, ki ngā puna kōrero;
- Ngā momo puna awhina, puna kōrero rānei:
 - » he kōrero ā-waha: he uiui i ngā kaumātua, i ngā pakeke, i ngā rangatira, i ngā mātanga rānei;
 - » ngā pukapuka i whakaputaina;
 - » ngā pukapuka kāore anō i whakaputaina;
 - » ngā wāhitau ipurangi, ngā honongaitua rānei.

Assessment Specifications

Tauira will select a Te Ao Haka performance item from their own Kura and any Kapa Haka who stood at any of the Kura Tuarua Nationals Competitions. Tauira will draw an understanding of key features and elements from their chosen performance item.

Ākonga will be required to select **TWO** performances and respond in the form of an essay. The essay will require ākonga to select at least **FOUR** key features and at least **FOUR** elements and show their understanding of how these enhanced the performance (see the Te Ao Haka glossary of a description on “key features” and “elements” ([Te Ao Haka | NCEA \(education.govt.nz\)](#))).

The report must be no less than 400 words and no more than 500 words. Ākonga will have access to their selected performances during the assessment and may refer to the recordings as needed.

The Kete Manarua displays some examples as options for the teacher. It is for the teacher to decide whether to use these example(s), whether to use practice work, or whether to prepare another Assessment Task.

Conditions of the Assessment

This is an individual piece of work with evidence preparation for external assessment by the student. To successfully complete this Digital Kete Manarua:

- must be published as a PDF;
- the file size must remain under 5GB to enable smooth uploading to the Online Digital Submission Portal;
- the work must be correctly organized;
- the work must be correctly laid out (must not be sideways or upside down);
- the document must be securely attached to the cover page, and submission of separate files is not permitted.

Ākonga Authenticity Statement

How will the authenticity of the work by the ākonga be authenticated? A process and evidential trail must be evident in order to demonstrate the authenticity of a student's work. The students, teachers and school community should be aware of the authenticity process.

Plagiarism is an easy error to avoid. The ākonga may cite the people and bodies of works referred to in their work.

For example:

- a brief sentence showing the origins of the work
- a reference page is attached at the end of the written task
- an acknowledgement to the person, or source of assistance
- the different forms of information support:
 - » oral communication: interviewing elders, adults, leaders, experts
 - » published works
 - » unpublished works
 - » websites and hyperlinks.
