Te Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā)

He Aromatawai ā-waho te Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā), ka whakaritea ōna tūmahi, ka mākahia hoki ngā urupare a te ākonga e Te Mana Tohu Mātauranga o Aotearoa (NZQA).

Te Whakahaere TAPā i te Kura

Ka whakahaerehia te TAPā e te kura, i te kura i 'Te Rā Aromatawai'.

Mā te Mana Tohu Mātauranga o Aotearoa te taupānga rorohiko e whakawātea, e aukati hoki.

Hei waenga i te 8.30 (i te ata) me te 5.30 (i te ahiahi) ka whakawāteahia te taupānga rorohiko (te Assessment Master) e whakaoti ai ngā ākonga i te TAPā.

Ka 90 meneti te roa o te wā ki ngā ākonga hei whakaoti i te TAPā.

Ka āta whakaritea tētahi/ētahi wāhi motuhake (hei tauira; tētahi rūma nui, tētahi akomanga rānei) e wātea ana ngā rauemi nei; arā, ngā kaiwhakarato ipurangi, ngā rorohiko, ngā tēpu, ngā tūru, ngā pepa ohia manomano, ngā pene anō hoki.

Te Whakatakotoranga Aromatawai

E **WHĀ** ngā kiriata o te tūmahi nei – e rua ngā kiriata nō Te Ao Haka, e rua nō tūmomo kanikani kē. Kei ia kiriata tōna ake kōrero āpiti, i te reo Māori, i te reo Pākehā hoki.

Me whiriwhiria te ākonga e rua ngā kiriata, tētahi nō Te Ao Haka, tētahi anō nō tūmomo kanikani

kē, ā, whakamahia, whakatauritea ngā kiriata kua tīpakohia ki te whakautu i ngā pātai katoa o te tūmahi.

Me tīpakohia te ākongā e WHĀ ngā huānga, kia kitea te mōhio me te māramatanga o ngā tūnga, o ngā huānga anō hoki.

- I te wā o te aromatawai ā-waho, me aro anake ngā ākongā ki ngā rauemi kua whakaaetia mō te aromatawai ā-waho.
- Kāore e whakaaetia ana te kawē tuhinga kē, te kawē rauemi tautoko kē rānei ki roto i te rūma aromatawai ā-waho.
- Ka 90 meneti noa te roa ki te ākongā hei whakaoti i tēnei TAPā.
- Mō te tūpono ka raru te ipurangi, ka tukua hoki he kape ā-pepa.

The Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā)

This is a 'Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi' (TAPā), or 'Common Assessment Activity' (CAA), prepared and administered by New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA). The scheduled date for completing this TAPā is **3 Wednesday, September**. The New Zealand Qualifications Authority will send a link to the TAPā.

TAPā Management at Kura

The TAPā will be managed by the school on the 'The Assessment Date'.

New Zealand Qualifications Authority will enable and restrict the computer application.

Between 8:30 am and 5:30 pm, the site (Assessment Master) will be made available for students to complete the TAPā.

Students will have 90 minutes to complete the TAPā.

Specific spaces will be carefully prepared (for example, a large room or a classroom) with the following resources available: internet providers, computers, tables, chairs, sufficient blank papers, and pens.

External Assessment Specifications

A Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPA), or Common Assessment Activity (CAA), is developed and marked by NZQA and administered by a school in a single session during the period of assessment specified above.

Ākonga will be provided with video recordings of **FOUR** performances – two from Te Ao Haka and two from other performing arts. An English and/or te reo Māori synopsis of performances will be provided.

Ākonga will be required to select **TWO** performances (one Te Ao Haka performance and one other performing arts) and respond in short and / or extended answers to questions comparing the two performances. Questions will require ākonga to select **FOUR** elements and show their understanding of how these are expressed in both performances (see the achievement standard for more information on “elements” [Te Ao Haka | NCEA \(education.govt.nz\)](#)).

Ākonga will have access to their selected performances during the assessment and may refer to the recordings as needed.

Responses may be written in Māori or English, not both.

Conditions of the Assessment

The student must complete this TAPā in front of the teacher, and must also follow the external assessment rules:

- During the external assessment, students may only refer to the resources that have been approved for the external assessment.
- Bringing in other writing or other supporting resources into the external assessment room is not permitted.
- Students have 90 minutes only to complete this TAPā.
- In the event of internet disruption, a paper copy will also be provided.
