He Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā) tēnei, ka whakaritea, ka mākahia hoki e Te Mana Tohu Mātauranga o Aotearoa (NZQA). Ka whakahaeretia tēnei TAPā e ngā Kaiwhakahaere Whakamātautau puta noa i ngā kura kua whakaaetia hei wāhi whakamātautau.

Ahakoia he TAPā tēnei aromatawai ā-waho, me ū ki ngā ture katoa o te whakamātautau ā-waho.

Ka tīmata te TAPā i te ahiahi. Nā, ahakoia he toru hāora te roa o tēnei TAPā, tērā pea ka oti ki roto i te iwa tekau meneti.

Te Whakatakotoranga Aromatawai ā-waho

E **WHĀ** ngā kiriata o te tūmahi nei – e **RUA** ngā kiriata nō Te Ao Haka, e **RUA** anō nō ngā tūmomo kanikani kē. Kei ia kiriata tāna ake kōrero āpiti, i te reo Māori, i te reo Pākehā hoki.

Me whiriwhiri te ākonga e rua ngā kiriata, tētāhi nō Te Ao Haka, tētāhi anō nō tūmomo

kanikani kē, ā, whakamahia, whakatauritea ngā kiriata kua tīpakohia ki te whakautu i ngā pātai katoa o te tūmahi.

Me tīpako te ākonga e **TORU** ngā huānga (Ngā Kaupapa), kia kitea te mōhio me te māramatanga o ngā tūnga, o ngā huānga anō hoki.

Ngā Herenga Aromatawai ā-waho

Me tutuki tēnei whakamātautau ki mua i te aroaro o te Kaiwhakahaere Whakamātautau, ki te wāhi tū ai ngā whakamātautau ā-waho, ā, me whai i ngā ture whakamātautau anō hoki.

The Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā)

This Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPā), or Common Assessment Activity (CAA), is developed and marked by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA).

This TAPā will be administered by the Exam Centre Manager. Though the mode of assessment is a TAPā, the end of year examination rules apply.

External Assessment Specifications

A Tūmahi Aromatawai Pātahi (TAPA), or Common Assessment Activity (CAA), is developed and marked by NZQA and administered by a school in a single session during the period of assessment specified above.

Ākonga will be provided with video recordings of **FOUR** performances – two from Te Ao Haka and two from other performing arts. An English and/or te reo Māori synopsis of performances will be provided.

Ākonga will be required to select **TWO** performances (one Te Ao Haka performance and

one other performing arts) and respond in short and / or extended answers to questions comparing the two performances. Questions will require ākonga to select **THREE** elements and show their understanding of how these are expressed in both performances (see the achievement standard for more information on “elements” - [Te Ao Haka | NCEA \(education.govt.nz\)](#)).

Ākonga will have access to their selected performances during the assessment and may refer to the recordings as needed.

Responses may be written in Māori or English, not both.

Content/ Context Details

Ākonga will demonstrate knowledge of tikanga through this standard and that Te Ao Haka categories require correct expression, built upon culture and identity. They will also show that Te Ao Haka is a vehicle for understanding Māori culture and practices.

Conditions of the External Assessment

The TAPā must be managed by the Exam Centre Manager. Candidates completing this TAPā must observe all [NCEA - Assessment and Examination Rules and Procedures](#). During the assessment the candidate may only use the resources provided for the task.

No written material or other resources may be taken into the examination room. The candidate must complete the TAPā within the allotted time of three hours.

The candidate may choose to respond in English or te reo Māori.
