## He Whakamātautau ā-Matihiko

Hei kōnae ā-matihiko te aromatawai ā-waho nei, e taea ai e ngā ākonga te whakamātautau nei te whakaoti i te rorohiko.

He tuhinga rānei, he whakaahua pateko rānei, ko aua āhuetanga e rua rānei, ngā rauemi i te aromatawai ā-matihiko nei.

Ka kitea anō ētahi pārongo mō ngā aromatawai ā-matihiko i te whārangi ipurangi a Te Mana Tohu Mātauranga o Aotearoa.

- Ka tuhia ngā tohutohu me ngā pātai ki te reo Māori me te reo Pākehā, engari, me tuhi ngā ākonga i ngā whakautu mō ia whakamātautau ki te reo Māori.

Instructions and questions will be in both te reo Māori and English but candidates will be required to write all their answers in te reo Māori.

- Ka pānui te ākonga i tētahi tuhinga reo Māori, ā, ka whakautua ngā pātai ki te reo Māori e hāngai ana ki ngā horopaki ā-rohe, ā-motu, ā-ao anō hoki. **Me tuhi ngā whakautu katoa ki te reo Māori.** Ka āpitihia atu he kupu taka ki te whakamātautau mō ngā kupu hou.

Candidates read and respond to a written text that will relate to local, national and global themes in te reo Māori. **All answers will be written in te reo Māori.** A glossary will be provided in the exam for unfamiliar words.

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### He Whakamātautau ā-Matihiko

E wātea ana te aromatawai hei kōnae matihiko, e taea ai e ngā ākonga te whakaoti ā-rorohiko te aromatawai, tē tahuri kē ai ki te whakakī i te aromatawai ā-pepa mō taua kaupapa.

Ko ngā rauemi e takoto ana i te aromatawai ā-matihiko: Te whakapuaki whakaaro hei tuhinga whakamōhio, te pānui kia mōhio ki te reo o tōna ao.

Ka kitea ētahi pārongo atu anō mō ngā aromatawai ā-waho e matihiko ana, mō te tau 2024 ki te whārangi ipurangi a Te Mana Tohu Mātauranga o Aotearoa.

- Ka tuhia ngā tohutohu me ngā pātai ki te reo Māori me te reo Pākehā, engari, me tuhi ngā ākonga i ngā whakautu mō ia whakamātautau ki te reo Māori anake.

Instructions and questions will be in both te reo Māori and English but candidates will be required to write all their answers in te reo Māori.

- Me tuhi te ākonga i **TĒTAHI** tuhinga ki te reo Māori e neke atu ana i te **400 ngā kupu**. Ka hāngai ngā kaupapa ki ngā take ā-rohe, ā-motu, ā-ao anō hoki i ngā momo tuhinga rerekē.

Candidates will be required to write **ONE** piece of writing of at least **400 words** in te reo Māori. Topics will cover local, national, and global themes across different text types.

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
