

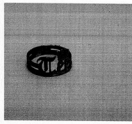

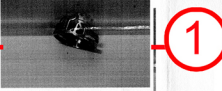
The ring is from Thailand, it made from brass.

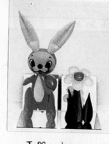

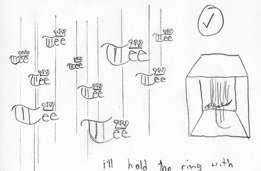

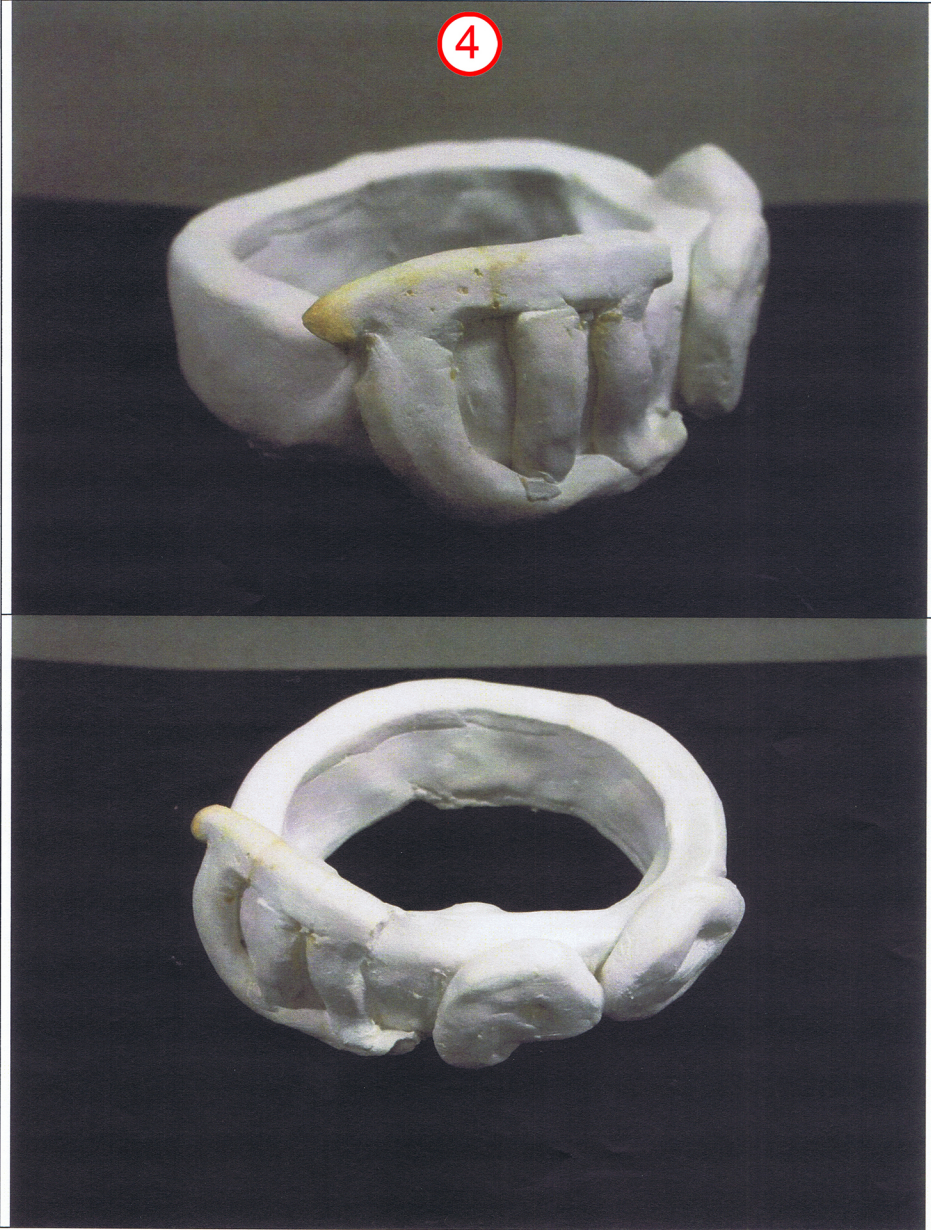
