



In this method I have used mostly an F image. This image is an F stand and I have surrounded it with one type of green. I have also kept the FTS just to clarify what kind of method it is.



In this method I tried to keep the design simple I have used limited color in a circle round the F which is white rather than black creating contrast and isolating it as the more important of the three letters.



In this method I have used a couch substrate combined with text and sans font. The main font is larger and also colored in green which are the colours of my board. I have limited the amount of colour so add the small amount of colour products together the sofa has white contrasting the substrate and a touch under the contrasting letter of its meaning which did not put together.



In this method I have used a small range which could possibly be used in several of my methods as a single starting point of my company logo. Again I have used limited colour and make the substrate smaller than the font which has an image of a sofa both which is simple. I have also experimented with a new type face which I like better than the previous one.

In this method I tried to use an image related to the cooking side of living. Although I have done this I don't think it works very well as a method, it seems busy and it has too many clashing colours. The text is still holds its own but doesn't work with the image.



In this method I have again used a small image combined with text which I have modified a bit. I have used a shopping cart substrate this time which also relates to flatmate. Have again gone back to the two colors of green, but this has been with the text fts. I have overtyped it and then taken the difference this makes the T look more intensity and stands up the color.



In this method I have looked at one of my artist models and emulated what they did. I made the F flow with the curves of the circle which makes an interesting method. I have kept the text with hierarchy with the text progressively getting smaller as importance does. Again I have used limited color and kept it green.



In this method I tried to emulate the style of one of my artist models designs which used a similar design in terms of a shield. I thought this could make an appropriate method seeing as my company is a school and generally schools have a shield or crest as their logo. Again I have used limited colour and kept the same green colours. I feel these goes with well together. I have also experimented with a different text, but in this case I will discard it.


