

In this masthead I have used mostly an image. This image is an icon and I have surrounded it with one type of green. I have also kept the 'FTS' just to clarify what kind of masthead it is.

In this masthead I tried to keep the design simple. I have limited colour in a circle round the 'F' which is white rather than black creating contrast and isolating it as the more important of the three letters.



In this masthead I have used a couch silhouette combined with text and sub-text. The main text is large and also coloured in green which are the colours of my board. I have limited the amount of colour so that the small amount of colour attracts attention. The sub-text is white contrasting the silhouette and is roughly under the corresponding letter of its meaning which links the parts together.

In this masthead I have used a small image which could possibly be used in several of my mastheads as a single identifying point of my company. Again I have used limited colour and made the sub-text smaller than the main text. I made the sub-text smaller than the main text of a spray bottle silhouette to show which is common in all flats. I also experimented with a new type face which I like better than the previous one.



In this masthead I tried to use an image related to the cooking side of things. Although I have done this I don't think it works very well as a masthead, it seems too big and it has too many clashing colours. The text still holds its own but doesn't work with the image.



In this masthead I have looked at one of my artist models and emulated what they did. I made the 'F' flow with the curves of the circle which makes an interesting masthead. I have kept the text with the masthead and it is sized in hierarchy with the text progressively getting smaller as importance drops. Again I have used limited colour and kept it green.



In this masthead I tried to emulate the style of one of my artist models designs which used a similar design in terms of a shield. I thought this could make an appropriate masthead seeing as my company is a school and generally schools have a shield or crest as their logo. Again I have used limited colour and kept the same green colours. I feel these agree with each other. I have also experimented with a different text, but in this case I will discard it.

In this masthead I have again used a small image combined with text which I have modified a bit. I have used a shopping cart silhouette this time, which also relates to flatting. I have again gone back to the two tones of green, but this had with the text I have overlaid it and then taken the difference, this makes the T look more interesting and breaks up the colour.



In this masthead I have experimented with using mostly simple images to create an interesting masthead. The images could probably hold their own, but I think that would suggest too much that this is a cleaning company rather than a flatmate training company. So I kept the text there as not to cause confusion, and it also relates to some of my artist models. I have used limited colour, this is true to the one type of green just to experiment with how it looks. Up
