POSSIBLE SCULPTURES FOR THE NEXT STANDARD

1) Make a sculpture of a barble doll head, covered I drowned

I based this sculpture on the artist Ewa Mos but instead of using four
















Artist model - Michael Mapes Do a series of the same technique with pictures of both male and female. Using old clear make-up packages so you can still see the image I section through the plastic.
