What is NCEA?

NCEA stands for the National Certificate of Educational Achievement. It's the main qualification for senior secondary school students, and it's available at Levels 1, 2 and 3 on the New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF).



NCEA is open for everyone, whether you want to do an apprenticeship, go to university, or be ready to get a job when you leave school.

What are STEM subjects and why are they important?

STEM stands for science, technology, engineering and maths. The government has identified these subject areas as very important for New Zealand's future. It is predicted that almost all future jobs will require some STEM knowledge.



There are many reasons to study STEM subjects at secondary school: *they can lead to better paid/more secure jobs, STEM jobs are increasingly important for New Zealand's future, there are skill shortages in related sectors.*
